

Annual Report - Part I Crime, 2009 Uniform Crime Reporting Data

The following report contains tables compiled from crime statistics for 2009. This data has been reported to the FBI and the Maryland State Police for Uniform Crime Reporting (U.C.R.) purposes.

Part I Crimes: Total Part I offenses decreased by **36%** in 2009 when compared to 2008.

The following Part I Offenses decreased in 2009; **Homicide** (down 50%), **Rape** (up 11%), **Robbery** (down 37%), **Aggravated Assault** (down 15%), **Burglary** (down 32%), **Larceny** (down 39%), and **Motor Vehicle Theft** (down 43%) compared to 2008.

There were **680 less** Part I Offenses in 2009 when compared to 2008.

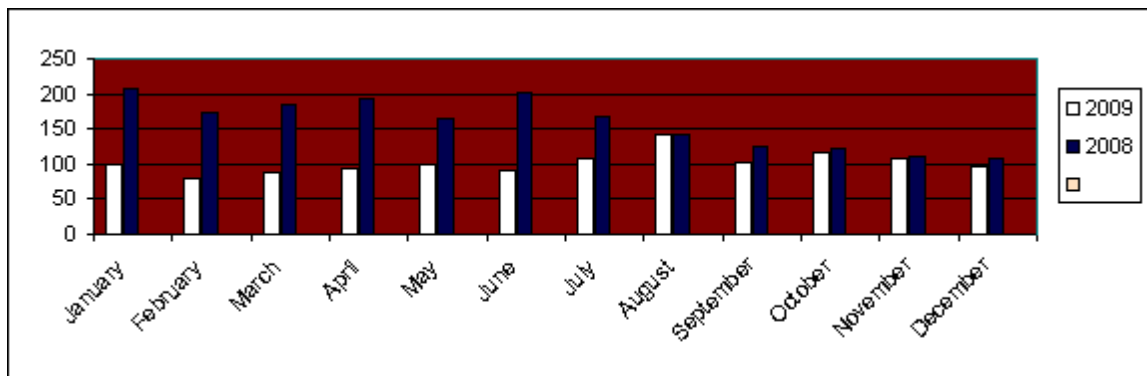

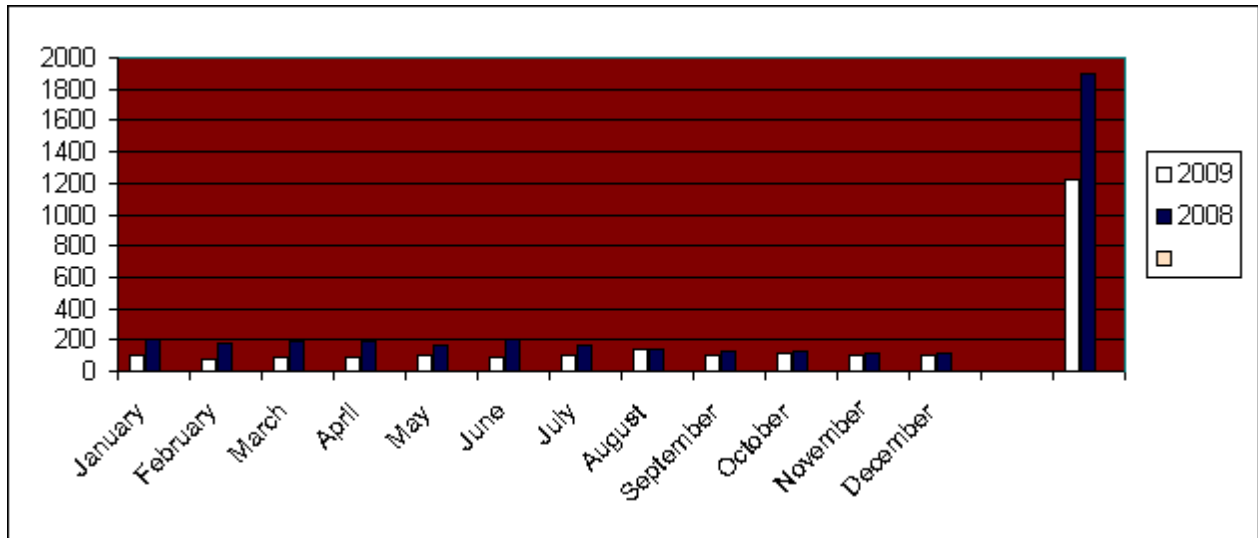

The 1,224 Part One crimes reported in 2009 are the lowest number since the 1975 inception of Uniform Crime Reporting. In 2008 - also a low crime year - the total was 1,904. The last time the Annapolis Police Department saw numbers under 2,000 for Part One Offenses were in 1978 at 1,891 and 1979 with 1,918.
